Activities

- 172 AS operating in BD. Includes Telco, ISP, Bank, University etc
- Will bring minimum 2 high level engineer from each AS in the research group
- Implement CIDR (www.cidr-report.org) report aggregation suggestion
- Validate IRT (Incidence Response Team) contact registered in APNIC whois to facilitate security incidence tracking in BD
- Be the first hand information source to the publication and media sector in Bangladesh on Internet operational technology and related issues

Stakeholder Coordination

- bdNOG support the current multi-stake holder model of Internet operation
